

1 AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN
2 FRANCISCO TO RETROACTIVELY APPLY FOR, ACCEPT AND EXPEND FUNDS MADE
3 AVAILABLE THROUGH THE OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE PLANNING FOR A
4 PROJECT ENTITLED "VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN VERTICAL PROSECUTION -
5 ELDER ABUSE" AND WAIVING INDIRECT COSTS DUE TO FUNDING CONSTRAINTS;

6 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco desires to
7 continue a certain project designated the Violence Against Women
8 Vertical Prosecution - Elder Abuse to be funded in part from funds
9 made available through the Violence Against Women Act ("VAWA"),
10 administered by the California Office of Criminal Justice Planning
11 ("OCJP"); and

12 WHEREAS, this project will investigate and vertically
13 prosecute cases of violence, domestic violence, and sexual assault
14 against elderly women and other particularly vulnerable victims;
15 therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That the District Attorney of the City and County of
17 San Francisco is authorized, retroactively, on behalf of the City
18 and County of San Francisco to accept and expend continued funding
19 for this project from OCJP, and waiving indirect costs due to
20 funding constraints; and be it

21 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized,

8 (including any amendments thereof) under the program and funding

12 performance of the Grant Award Agreement, including civil court
13 actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant
14 recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and
15 OCJP disclaim responsibility for any such liability; and be it

17 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall
18 not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.




