2 RESOLUTION DETERMINING THAT THE ISSUANCE OF A TYPE 20 OFF-SALE
3 BEER AND WINE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL LICENSE TO LEE SANDERS,
4 FOR 7-ELEVEN INC. LOCATED AT 2650 MASON STREET, WILL SERVE THE
5 PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY OF THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY AND
6 COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 23958.4 OF THE
7 CALIFORNIA BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONS CODE; WITH CONDITIONS.

9 WHEREAS, Lee Sanders is seeking issuance of a Type 20 off-sale beer and
10 wine alcoholic beverage control license for 7-Eleven Inc., located at 2650 Mason Street;
11 and,

12 WHEREAS, The City Planning Department has verified that the area is properly
13 zoned; and recommends approval; and,

14 WHEREAS, The Police Department recommends that the liquor license
15 application be approved with conditions; now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business
17 and Professions Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San
18 Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the issuance of a Type 20
19 off-sale beer and wine alcoholic beverage control license, to Lee Sanders for 7-Eleven
20 Inc., located at 2650 Mason Street will serve the public convenience and necessity of
21 the people of the City and County of San Francisco.

22 Conditions: 1) No wine shall be sold with an alcoholic content greater than 15%
23 by volume. 2) No beer products shall be sold in less than six pack quantities per sale. 3)
24 No beer shall be sold with an alcoholic content greater than 5.7% by volume (i.e. malt
25 liquor, stout).


