2 COMMENDING PATRICIA SIEGEL FOR HER COMMITMENT TO THE CHILDREN AND  
3 FAMILIES OF SAN FRANCISCO AND TO CHILDREN AND FAMILIES THROUGHOUT THE  
4 STATE OF CALIFORNIA AND DECLARING MARCH 6, 2000, TO BE "PATRICIA  
5 SIEGEL DAY" IN SAN FRANCISCO.

6 WHEREAS, For more than 30 years, Patricia Siegel has been  
7 actively involved in the development and delivery of child care  
8 services in California, becoming the founding director of one of the  
9 nation's first child care resource and referral agencies - The  
10 Children's Council/Childcare Switchboard in San Francisco; and,

11 WHEREAS, Since 1980, Patricia Siegel has served as the Executive  
12 Director of the California Child Care Resource and Referral Network,  
13 representing and assisting 61 local child care agencies in providing  
14 services to children and families in San Francisco and throughout the  
15 State of California; and,

16 WHEREAS, In her capacity as Executive Director, Patricia  
17 recently released a report which showed that we are facing a crisis  
18 with the dramatic exodus of child care workers from the field, a  
19 crisis that is particularly acute in San Francisco, where there are  
20 more than three children for every one child care slot available;  
21 and,

22 WHEREAS, Patricia's current work includes the Child Care  
23 Initiative Project to expand the supply of licensed quality child  
24 care by recruiting and training new family child care providers, with  
25

1 special emphasis on infants and toddlers and Spanish speaking  
2 communities; and,

3 WHEREAS, As a member of the California Children and Families  
4 First Commission, Patricia is also actively leading the fight against  
5 Proposition 28; now, therefore be it

6 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County  
7 of San Francisco commends Patricia Siegel for her commitment to the  
8 children and families of San Francisco and children and families  
9 throughout the State of California; and be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and  
11 County of San Francisco hereby declares March 6, 2000, to be  
12 "Patricia Siegel Day" in San Francisco.


