7 Hawaii from 1983-1986; and,

8 Whereas, She continued her work in public safety as a police officer in Hawaii from
9 1986-1990; and,

10 Whereas, Jane made her way to California as a San Anselmo police officer in 1990;
11 and,

12 Whereas, Jane then joined the San Francisco Patrol Special Police in 1992 serving the
13 Castro District; and,

14 Whereas, Jane has organized special citizen patrols during periods of increased crime
15 in the area; and,

16 Whereas, She volunteered her services at the temporary queer youth shelter at Eureka
17 Valley Recreation Center from March through May of 1999, positively impacting the lives of
18 young people living on the streets; and,

19 Whereas, Jane organizes extra security forces during special events such as the Gay
20 Pride Parade, Halloween and New Year's Eve, making the neighborhood safer for celebrants
21 and local business owners; and,

22 Whereas, Her extraordinary love for stray and abandoned animals has resulted in
23 many of them being placed in loving homes; and,

24 Whereas, Jane is known and loved by many in the Castro simply as "Officer Jane";

1 Whereas, Officer Jane's care and concern for the community has made an untold
2 number of lives safer and happier in the Castro, prevented unnecessary injury and suffering,
3 and added to the quality of life for all residents and visitors to San Francisco, therefore, be it,

4 Resolved, That the City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby
5 commends Officer Jane Warner for her outstanding professional and volunteer contributions
6 as a San Francisco Special Patrol Officer in the Castro neighborhood.


