RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL FUNDING
APPLICATION

WHEREAS, San Francisco residents, including our youth, should have safe and equitable access to the transportation system in San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco is a compact city which offers opportunities for many youth to walk or bike to school; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco has a higher than average amount of bicycle use for transportation (between 3% - 4% of adult population), usage which should also be encouraged among our youth; and,

WHEREAS, bicycling and walking are fully sustainable modes of transportation that produce no pollution and that offer many economical, health, and community-building benefits; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco is a leading community in advocating for increased bicycle usage and safety; and,

WHEREAS, bicycle lane money is desperately needed to fund new bike projects in many neighborhoods of San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, the current level of funding is far short of the amount of money needed to create a safe, equitable, and integrated bike and pedestrian transportation infrastructure in San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco has adopted an official policy to promote traffic calming, particularly around school areas; now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
2 supports the "Safe Routes to Schools Project" submitted by San Francisco's Department
3 of Parking & Traffic; and, be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board of Supervisors hereby urges the California
5 Department of Transportation (Caltrans) to look favorably upon this proposal in the


