

[Commending Teacher Flex Program]

1 **COMMENDING BANK OF AMERICA FOR CREATING THE TEACHER FLEX HOME LOAN**
2 **PROGRAM FOR CALIFORNIA'S SCHOOL TEACHERS AND ADMINISTRATORS AND AS**
3 **WELL FOR CONTRIBUTING TO THE RECRUITMENT AND RETENTION OF CALIFORNIA**
4 **TEACHERS AND ASSISTING IN IMPROVING THE QUALITY OF EDUCATION FOR**
5 **CALIFORNIA'S SCHOOLCHILDREN.**

6 WHEREAS, The annual salaries of California teachers are not competitive with salaries
7 offered in other fields which necessitates the same level of education and training; and

8 WHEREAS, The high cost of purchasing a home in the Bay Area has cause many
9 talented and gifted San Francisco teachers to seek employment in other states; and

10 WHEREAS, The gradual loss of such gifted and dedicated teachers and school
11 administrators will negatively affect the quality of education for San Francisco's school
12 children; and

13 WHEREAS, Bank of America has introduced a new mortgage loan program called
14 "Teacher Flex Home Loans" to assist California teachers to become homeowners; and

15 WHEREAS, The intent of the of the loan program is to assist both private and public
16 school teachers and administrators so they can purchase a home in California which would in
17 turn contribute to more effective recruitment and retention of talented and dedicated teachers
18 as well as improved job performance; and

19 WHEREAS, The only qualification of the program is that the borrower be a California-
20 based public or private school teacher or administrator; and

21 WHEREAS, Bank of America's Teacher Flex program offers a 30 year fixed-rate
22 mortgage with a maximum loan amount of \$350,000 with a three percent down payment, of
23 which \$500 needs to come from the borrower's own funds; and

6 Program" for California teachers and school administrators; and

9 as well to helping to improve the quality of education for California' schoolchildren.




