4 WHEREAS, Continuum HIV Day Services is an innovative healthcare community
5 dedicated to enhancing the quality of life for persons living with HIV/AIDS by providing
6 professional health, social, and spiritual support and programs in a safe community setting;

8 WHEREAS, In July 1990, Continuum HIV Day Services became the second licensed
9 adult day health care center for people with HIV/AIDS in the United States; and,

10 WHEREAS, Continuum HIV Day Services is the only free standing adult day health
11 care center for people with HIV/AIDS; and,

12 WHEREAS, Continuum HIV Day Services administers the TLC Program to ensure
13 that all persons living with HIV/AIDS in the immediate Tenderloin neighborhood receive
14 ongoing, high quality primary care and other essential services and clients stabilize their lives
15 enough to enable them to negotiate the existing health care and social service systems; and,

16 WHEREAS, Continuum HIV Day Services administers the Springboard Project to
17 improve the health status of African Americans with HIV/AIDS being released from California
18 state prisons by linking them to appropriate, culturally-competent primary health care and
19 social services in San Francisco; and,

20 WHEREAS, Continuum HIV Day Services will celebrate its 10th anniversary during the
21 week of May 15, 2000; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
23 commends Continuum HIV Day Services on its 10th anniversary.
