3 CREATE A NEWCOMER HIGH SCHOOL ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

5 WHEREAS, Newcomer High School was founded in 1979; and,

6 WHEREAS, Since that time Newcomer High School has served thousands of students who have
7 newly immigrated to the United States and relocated in San Francisco; and,

8 WHEREAS, Newcomer High School specializes in serving students who speak little to no
9 English; and,

10 WHEREAS, this service is not provided elsewhere in the San Francisco Unified School District
11 in such a comprehensive manner; and,

12 WHEREAS, Newcomer High School provides a supportive environment for students to adjust
13 while they learn English and other subject matter; and

14 WHEREAS, Newcomer High School has proven to be an effective learning environment; and,

15 WHEREAS, Newcomer High School has been under constant threat of closure by the San
16 Francisco Unified School District; and,

17 WHEREAS, Newcomer High School has proven to be a great asset to the City and County of
18 San Francisco, contributing to the City's rich cultural diversity; and

19 WHEREAS, It would be beneficial to have an advisory committee focused on a forum dedicated
20 to providing input to the School District; and

21 WHEREAS, Such a forum would allow a broad-based group to participate in the ongoing
22 improvement of the curriculum and other services provided by Newcomer High School; now, therefore,
23 be it

24 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the San Francisco Unified
25 School District Board of Education to create a Newcomer High School Advisory Committee.




