5 RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Independent, a newspaper of
6 general circulation published in the City and County of San
7 Francisco for the dissemination of local or telegraphic news and
8 intelligence of a general character, having a bona fide
9 circulation of at least 50,000 copies per calendar week, printed
10 in the City and County on three or more days in a calendar week,
11 is hereby designated as an official newspaper of the City and
12 County of San Francisco, commencing July 1, 2000 for the
13 publication of all official advertising of the City and County
14 which is required by law, other than the provisions of Section
15 2.103 of the Charter as they relate to special meetings of the
16 Board of Supervisors and its special or standing committees, to
17 be published one time, and all official advertising of the City
18 and County which is required by law to be published more than
19 one, but not more than three times per week for a specified
20 number of weeks.


