

1 [State Housing Budget]

2 URGING GOVERNOR DAVIS TO ALLOCATE \$575 MILLION IN NEW GENERAL FUND
3 MONEY FOR AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROGRAMS.

4 WHEREAS, California needs 250,000 new housing units annually,
5 but is producing only 120,000 annually; and,

6 WHEREAS, California needs 100,000 new low income housing units
7 annually, but is producing under 27,000 annually; and,

8 WHEREAS, According to the Association of Bay Area Governments
9 (ABAG), San Francisco will need close to 20,400 new housing units
10 over the next 7 ½ years, of which 7,370 will be for low or very low
11 income households; and,

12 WHEREAS, While the demand for housing keeps growing,
13 approximately 500 new housing units is all that are built for low
14 income families each year in San Francisco; and,

15 WHEREAS, Based on 1993 data, 137,900 households in San Francisco
16 were paying more than 30% of their income on rent and, of that
17 number, 61,700 were spending more than 50% of their income on rent;
18 these percentages have presumably grown since 1993 with an
19 increasingly expensive real estate market in San Francisco; and,

20 WHEREAS, When applications were solicited recently for 55
21 affordable housing units nearing completion, there were 5,700
22 individuals who applied for those units; and,

23 WHEREAS, The Bay Area is project to lose 41,000 units of federal
24 Section 8 housing in upcoming years; and,

1 WHEREAS, The State Legislature's proposed FY 2000-2001 budget
2 contains a \$575 million budget increase for affordable housing
3 programs, \$252 million of which is earmarked for the construction,
4 rehabilitation and preservation of low income rental units; and,

5 WHEREAS, \$252 million will allow for construction/rehabilitation
6 of up to 11,100 low income rental units; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County
8 of San Francisco urges Governor Davis to allocate \$575 million in new
9 general fund money for affordable housing programs; and, be it
10 further

11 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors asks that a copy of this
12 resolution be forwarded to his Honor, the Mayor, with a request that
13 he transmit copies to Governor Davis.


