11 pesticides, the City and County of San Francisco adopted the landmark Integrated Pest
12 Management (IPM) Ordinance; and,

13 **WHEREAS**, Lyn Hawkins, was instrumental in the development of the IPM
14 Ordinance and the key first years of implementation of the City and County's IPM
15 Program; and,

16 **WHEREAS**, Lyn Hawkins, assisted in crafting an effective and
17 comprehensive pest management plan for the San Francisco Agricultural Commissioner's
18 Office and all other departments in the City and County of San Francisco; and,

19 **WHEREAS**, He worked closely with environmental organizations, business
20 and municipalities across the country to encourage the proliferation of pesticide reduction
21 programs; and,

22 **WHEREAS**, By implementing the IPM Program, Lyn Hawkins provided
23 leadership by example for the County Agricultural Commissioners throughout California;




