1 URGING MUNI AND BART TO INCREASE AND EXTEND SERVICES ON THE OCCASION  
2 OF THE 30<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL GAY PRIDE PARADE TO BE CELEBRATED ON JUNE 25, 2000.

4 WHEREAS, The culture, history, and diversity of the gay, lesbian, bisexual and  
5 transgender community are celebrated annually during the Gay Pride Parade held during the  
6 last week of June; and

7 WHEREAS, The Pride Parade annually attracts nearly one million visitors from all over  
8 the world to San Francisco Bay Area; and

9 WHEREAS, International visitors, visitors from other parts of the United States, local  
10 Bay Area residents, San Francisco residents, parade organizers and parade participants have  
11 all requested that transportation services be enhanced to expedite the movement of people  
12 during the Pride Parade event; and

13 WHEREAS, Since much of Market Street will be closed to vehicular traffic, it is the  
14 desire of the City and County of San Francisco to accommodate the increased number of  
15 tourists, visitors, and parade participants and expedite the transportation of parade  
16 participants during the event; and

17 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
18 urges both MUNI and BART to increase and extend transportation services on the occasion  
19 of the 30<sup>th</sup> annual Gay Pride Parade.




