1 URGING THE SAN FRANCISCO BOARD OF EDUCATION TO PLACE THE HIGHEST
2 PRIORITY UPON THE COMPLETION OF THE RENOVATION OF BESSIE CARMICHAEL
3 ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND FURTHER REQUESTING THAT NO NEW SCHOOL
4 CONSTRUCTION BE APPROVED UNTIL THE COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT AND
5 FURTHER REQUESTING THAT THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE SAN FRANCISCO
6 UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT TO INCLUDE THE RENOVATION OF BESSIE CARMICHAEL
7 AS PART OF THE NEXT FACILITIES BOND MEASURE TO BE PRESENTED TO THE
8 VOTERS OF SAN FRANCISCO.

9 WHEREAS, Bessie Carmichael Elementary School is a vibrant community of children,
10 parents, and teachers and whose members representative of the cultural and ethnic diversity
11 of San Francisco; and,

12 WHEREAS, Many of the students are low-income immigrant children who are members
13 of an ethnic and/or language minority group and thus are part of ; and

14 WHEREAS, Bessie Carmichael Elementary School is entirely housed in dilapidated,
15 unhealthy and unsightly temporary bungalows and

16 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Unified School District has entered into agreement with
17 the City and County of San Francisco to exchange adjacent properties to enable the creation
18 of a new South of Market Park and the construction of a new facility for Bessie Carmichael
Elementary School; and

19 WHEREAS, The project has been delayed while other projects have gone forth ; and

20 WHEREAS, The available and projected funds for this project appear to be inadequate
21 to complete the planned construction; now therefore be it

22 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco,
23 urges the San Francisco Board of Education to place the highest priority on the renovation
24 of Bessie Carmichael Elementary School; and be it

1 FUTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors requests the San Francisco
2 Board of Education not to approve any new school construction until the Bessie Carmichel
3 Renovation Project is completed; and be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors requests the Superintendent of
5 the San Francisco Unified School District to include the Bessie Carmichael Elementary
6 School Renovation Project in the next facilities bond measure to be presented to the voters of
7 San Francisco.




