

1 [Grant - State Funds]

2 AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKING AND
3 TRAFFIC TO RETROACTIVELY APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND EXPEND A GRANT IN THE
4 AMOUNT OF \$1,387,000 IN STIP FUNDS FOR VARIOUS TRANSPORTATION
5 PROJECTS.

6 WHEREAS, SB 45 (Chapter 622, Statutes 1997) substantially
7 revised the process for estimating the amount of state and federal
8 funds available for transportation projects in the state for
9 appropriating and allocating the available funds to these projects;
10 and,

11 WHEREAS, As part of that new process, the Metropolitan
12 Transportation Commission (MTC) is responsible for programming
13 projects eligible for State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP)
14 funds, pursuant to Government Code Section 14527(b), for inclusion in
15 the State Transportation Improvement Program, and submission to the
16 California Transportation Commission, for inclusion in the State
17 Transportation Improvement Program; and,

18 WHEREAS, MTC has requested eligible transportation project
19 sponsors to submit applications nominating projects to be programmed
20 for STIP funds in the 2000 State Transportation Improvement Program;
21 and,

22 WHEREAS, In January 2000 the San Francisco County Transportation
23 Authority adopted the San Francisco Corridor Management Program that
24 included the projects listed below; and

1 WHEREAS, The Department of Parking and Traffic is requesting a
2 STIP grant totaling \$900,000 to design, purchase, and install the
3 Third Street Integrated Traffic Management System; and,

4 WHEREAS, The Department of Parking and Traffic is requesting a
5 STIP grant totaling \$487,000 to install various pedestrian crossing
6 protection improvements including installing signs and signal
7 equipment, lighted crosswalks, and pedestrian signal countdown
8 devices at pedestrian and bicycle crossings at various locations;
9 and,

10 WHEREAS, The Parking and Traffic Commission approved Resolution
11 No. 109-00-PTC, authorizing the Executive Director of the Department
12 of Parking and Traffic to execute documents necessary to apply for,
13 accept, and expend \$2,895,000 of federal funds to implement five
14 safety projects, including the two aforementioned projects; and,

15 WHEREAS, Indirect costs are ineligible according to State of
16 California rules and regulations; and,

17 WHEREAS, There are no required local matching funds under the
18 STIP, now, therefore be it

19 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize
20 the Executive Director of Parking and Traffic to retroactively apply
21 for, accept and expend \$1,387,000 in State Transportation Improvement
22 Program funds for the aforementioned traffic projects and to execute
23 any and all documents necessary therefor.
