CONCURRING WITH THE CONTROLLER'S CERTIFICATION THAT THE LAUNDRY

FRANCISCO GENERAL HOSPITAL BY PRIVATE CONTRACTOR FOR A LOWER COST
THAN SIMILAR WORK PERFORMED BY CITY AND COUNTY EMPLOYEES:

WHEREAS, the electorate of the City and County of San Francisco passed Proposition J
in November 1976, adding Section 8.300-1 to the Charter allowing City Departments to contract
with private companies for specific services which can be performed for a lower cost than similar
work by City and County employees; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health, San Francisco General Hospital, is
accessing a Purchaser's awarded contract for these Laundry Services, and


WHEREAS, the Controller has certified on June 29, 2000, that said services can be
performed at lower costs to the City and County by private contractor than by employees of the
City and County; now, therefore be it

June 30, 2002.






