2 COMMENDING FRANK CUNEO FOR AIDING IN THE APPREHENSION OF TWO
3 FUGITIVES WANTED IN CONNECTION WITH A NATIONWIDE ANTI-GAY CRIME SPREE.

5 WHEREAS, Frank Cuneo was working as a bouncer at The Café on Market Street in
6 San Francisco on Saturday, August 19, 2000; and,

7 WHEREAS, His interactions that night with two young men with thick Boston accents,
8 while recalling their description from a police flyer, led him to suspect that they were the same
9 individuals wanted in connection with a coast-to-coast crime spree that targeted patrons of
10 gay bars; and,

11 WHEREAS, Frank's calm demeanor and level headed decision to quietly contact
12 police led to the two suspects' apprehension a few moments later, possibly saving
13 unsuspecting future victims untold pain and suffering; and,

14 WHEREAS, This kind of heroic action from a past victim of an anti-gay attack
15 represents the best kind of crime fighting and serves as an example of both the prevalence of
16 anti-gay violence and the importance of a community's efforts to work together with law
17 enforcement to catch wanted criminals; now, therefore be it

18 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby
19 commends Frank Cuneo for aiding in the apprehension of two fugitives wanted in connection
20 with a nationwide anti-gay crime spree.
