2 PROCLAIMING SEPTEMBER 2, 2000 SOCIETY OF THE 3RD INFANTRY DIVISION DAY
3 IN THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO.

5 WHEREAS, The 3rd Infantry Division departed from San Francisco 50
6 years ago to serve in the Korean War; and,

7 WHEREAS, The 3rd Infantry Division has a long legacy with San
8 Francisco dating back to 1917; and,

9 WHEREAS, The 3rd Infantry Division bravely prevented Germany's
10 takeover of Paris in World War I to distinguish themselves as the
11 "Marne" Infantry Division; and,

12 WHEREAS, The current 3rd Infantry Division Commander, Major
13 General Walter I. Sharp, represented by Colonel Michael Parker, and
14 the Consul General of the Republic of Korea, Tae-hyun Yoo are present
15 to commend the valor of the veterans of the Korean War; and,

16 WHEREAS, San Francisco has not overlooked the service of the
17 valiant soldiers who fought in the Korean War, also known as the
18 Forgotten War; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors and the City and County
