2 COMMENDING THE FANG FAMILY ON THE SUCCESSFUL ACQUISITION OF THE SAN  
3 FRANCISCO EXAMINER AND PAVING THE WAY AS THE FIRST ASIAN AMERICAN OWNERS  
4 OF A MAJOR METROPOLITAN DAILY NEWSPAPER.

5 WHEREAS, the late John Fang came to the United States from China  
6 almost 50 years ago, eventually studying at the U.C. Berkeley School of  
7 Journalism and returning to Taiwan in 1960 to marry Florence Lee; and,

8 WHEREAS, upon returning to the States, the Fang's felt the need to  
9 establish an English-language publication for American-born Asians who did  
10 not have the skills to read Asian languages in order to bridge the gap  
11 between their Asian-born counterparts and begin a dialog between the two  
12 groups; and,

13 WHEREAS, in 1978, Mr. Fang began work on what would be the first  
14 issue of AsianWeek; and,

15 WHEREAS, in the mid-80's, Mr. Fang acquired the ailing Lake Merced  
16 Independent as well as the San Francisco Progress and merged them into the  
17 San Francisco Independent; and,

18 WHEREAS, subsequently, the Fang family purchased several weeklies  
19 throughout the Bay Area which collectively has now come to be known as The  
20 Independent Group; and,

21 WHEREAS, on July 28, 2000, after months of negotiations, the San  
22 Francisco Examiner was successfully acquired by the Fang family from the  
23 Hearst Corporation; therefore, be it

2 family for not only acquiring the San Francisco Examiner, but for their  
3 extraordinary vision and perseverance as well.


