3 **COMMENCE PLANNING FOR A LESBIAN, GAY, BISEXUAL AND TRANSGENDER**  
4 **COMMUNITY CENTER TO PROVIDE SOCIAL SERVICE AND A SAFE GATHERING**  
5 **SPACE FOR ITS GAY AND LESBIAN RESIDENTS.**

6 WHEREAS, Cities all over the world, including Los Angeles, New York and Sacramento  
7 in the United States have opened Community Centers to serve the special needs of its  
8 lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender communities;

9 WHEREAS, These Community Centers function to provide social services and a safe  
10 gathering spaces for its lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender communities as well as a  
11 venue to exhibit the works of gay and lesbian artists; and

12 WHEREAS, San Francisco is currently pursuing the construction of its own Gay and  
13 Lesbian Community Center with economic development assistance from the City and County  
14 of San Francisco and donations from the private sector and the Center is projected to open in  
15 2001; and

16 WHEREAS, Mexico City has a large and vibrant gay and lesbian community who still  
17 face significant discrimination based on their sexual orientation; and

18 WHEREAS, A Gay and Lesbian Community Center would demonstrate to the  
19 community that the City is committed to the well-being of all its residents and embraces the  
20 contributions that gay and lesbian residents can make to the City as a whole; now, therefore,  
21 be it

22 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges Mayor of Mexico City,  
23 Andrés Manuel López Obrador to commence planning for a Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and  
24 Transgender Community Center to provide social services and a safe gathering space for its  
25 gay and lesbian residents.




