2 PROCLAIMING SEPTEMBER 20TH AS UNDOING RACISM DAY.

4 WHEREAS, By Act of Congress of the United States dated July 2, 1964, the Civil
5 Rights Act of 1964 was adopted banning discrimination because of a person's color, race,
6 national origin, religion, or sex; and,

7 WHEREAS, By Act of Congress of the United States dated December 6, 1865, the 13th
8 Amendment of the Constitution of the United States was adopted abolishing slavery; and,

9 WHEREAS, By Act of Congress the United States dated July 9, 1868, the 14th
10 Amendment of the Constitution of the United States was adopted giving all persons born or
11 naturalized in the United States the right to due process and equal protection under the law;
12 and,

13 WHEREAS, By resolution of the City and County of San Francisco, we declare racism
14 unjust and advocate equal rights for all; now, therefore, be it

15 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco proclaims September 20,
16 2000 as "Undoing Racism Day" in San Francisco and urge all citizens to join together for the
17 first annual "Undoing Racism Day" to reaffirm our commitment to ensure equality and freedom
18 for all people regardless of race, religion, sexual orientation, or gender; and be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco become a
20 signatory to this resolution as it was advanced by the National League of Cities; and, be it

21 FURTHER RESOLVED That a copy of this resolution be sent to the National League
22 of Cities, Attention: "Undoing Racism Day" Campaign, 1301 Pennsylvania Avenue, NW,
23 Washington, DC 20004-1763.
