7 WHEREAS, the Federal Aviation Administration (the "FAA") provides essential
8 services, installs, operates, and maintains all air navigational instruments and sites at the Airport
9 in order to ensure the safety of aircraft movements at San Francisco International Airport; and

10 WHEREAS, the FAA proposes to install, operate, and maintain an Approach Lighting
11 System with Sequence Flasher II (ALSF-2) on Runway 28R under Lease No. DTFA08-00-L-
12 20265; and

13 WHEREAS, the Airport Commission deems that the Approach Lighting System with
14 Sequence Flasher II (ALSF-2) is essential to the safety of aircraft movements at San Francisco
15 International Airport;

17 WHEREAS, on August 1, 2000, pursuant to Resolution No. 00-0282, the Airport
18 Commission approved the Lease with the United States of America. A copy of the form of the
19 Lease in on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 001590; now, therefore,


