6 **WHEREAS**, Section 10.104.15 of the San Francisco Charter allows Departments
7 to contract for services performed by employees subject to civil service
8 examination when it has been determined by the Controller that the work can be
9 practically performed under private contract at a lesser cost to the City than
10 similar work performed by employees; and

11 **WHEREAS**, The Municipal Transportation Agency desires to provide comprehensive
12 facility security services to protect its employees and assets through a private
13 security contractor; and

14 **WHEREAS**, The Office of the Controller has certified that for the six-month
15 period ending January 8, 2001, contracting for facility security services with
16 a private contractor is more economical than providing the same services with
17 City and County employees; and

18 **WHEREAS**, The Controller's certification is on file with Clerk of Board of
19 Supervisors in File No. 001604, now therefore be it

20 **RESOLVED**, That the Board of Supervisors concurs/^{retroactively}with and adopt the
21 Controller's certification that facility security services for the Municipal
22 Transportation Agency can be practically performed by a private contractor at a
23 lower cost than by City and County employees for the six-month period ending
24 January 8, 2001.





APPROVING A LEASE AGREEMENT FOR THE INSTALLATION AND OPERATION OF
A SOIA LOCALIZER, A NAVIGATIONAL AID INSTRUMENT ON RUNWAY 28R
BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND THE CITY AND COUNTY OF
SAN FRANCISCO, ACTING BY AND THROUGH ITS AIRPORT COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, the Federal Aviation Administration (the "FAA") provides essential
services, installs, operates, and maintains all air navigational instruments and sites at the Airport
in order to ensure the safety of aircraft movements at San Francisco International Airport; and

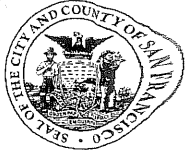
WHEREAS, the FAA proposes to install, operate, and maintain a SOIA Localizer, a
navigational aid instrument on Runway 28R under Lease No. DTFA08-00-L-19973; and

WHEREAS, the Airport Commission deems that this navigational aid instrument is
essential to the safety of aircraft movements at San Francisco International Airport; and

WHEREAS, on August 1, 2000, pursuant to Resolution No. 00-0282A, the Airport
Commission approved the Lease with the United States of America. A copy of the form of the
Lease in on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 001602; now, therefore,
be it

RESOLVED, that this Board of Supervisors hereby approves retroactively Lease No. DTFA08-00-L-
19973 for the placement of the SOIA Localizer on Runway 28R, between the United States of
America and the City and County of San Francisco, acting by and through its Airport
Commission on the terms and conditions set forth in the Director's Memorandum.




