[Nextel Communications Transmitter Lease]

Resolution authorizing and approving a lease of cellular transmitter space at the San Francisco General Hospital Garage to Nextel Communications.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby adopts the following findings regarding a proposed lease of cellular transmitter space within the San Francisco General Hospital (SFGH) Garage at 2500 24th Street, Block 4219 Lot 1 (the "Garage"), owned by the San Francisco Parking Authority (the "Authority"); the Director of Property has negotiated a form of agreement (the "Lease") with Nextel Communications ("Nextel") for the lease of the Premises for a monthly rental of \$3,000.00 for a term of five years, with the Authority having the right to extend the lease for a period of five years; and there is an annual rent increase based upon the Consumer Price Index and the rent will be reappraised prior to the exercise of the option; and the Lease also provides that the cost of all tenant improvements to the Premises will be borne by Nextel; and Nextel will pay all electric utility costs; and

WHEREAS, Nextel has received a City Planning Commission approval and the Authority approval by Resolution No. 114-00-PA, as well as a building permit to place a 332 sq. ft. equipment room with six cabinets on the fifth level and eleven antennae on the roof of the elevator tower at the SFGH Garage; and

RESOLVED, That in accordance with the recommendation of the Director of the
 Parking Authority and the Director of Property, the Mayor, the Clerk of the Board of
 Supervisors and the Director of Property are hereby authorized to take all actions, on
 behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, as Landlord, to execute a written lease and
 other related documents with Nextel, as Tenant; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, The Board of Supervisors hereby finds that it is in the best
interests of the Authority to enter into the Lease based upon direct negotiations with Nextel
without a competitive bid process. Competitive bidding in this situation would be
impracticable or impossible. There is sufficient space for a second cell phone company to
place a transmitter and antenna on this site; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, The Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to execute, and the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to attest and affix the seal of the City thereon, the Lease on behalf of the Parking Authority of San Francisco on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the lease shall be subject to and conditioned upon, the Human Rights Commission's approval of Nextel's compliance with City's Non-Discrimination and Equal Benefits in Employment Ordinance; and, be it
