3 AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH, HIV RESEARCH SECTION,  
4 TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$896,321 WITH THE  
5 UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, SAN FRANCISCO, THE PRIMARY CONTRACTOR, TO  
6 FUND THE ZIMBABWE-SAN FRANCISCO HIV PREVENTION TRIALS UNIT OF THE  
7 HIV PREVENTION TRIALS NETWORK; RETROACTIVE TO JULY 1, 2000.

8 WHEREAS, The University of California, San Francisco, has received funds from the  
9 National Institutes of Health for a project entitled The Zimbabwe-San Francisco HIV Prevention  
10 Trials Unit; and,

11 WHEREAS, The University of California, San Francisco, as the primary contractor has  
12 requested that the Department of Public Health, HIV Research Section, enter into an agreement  
13 to participate in this project by continuing to conduct a study with high-risk HIV uninfected men  
14 who have sex with men and provide local oversight and implementation of the protocol for this  
15 project; and,

16 WHEREAS, The University of California, San Francisco, has agreed to reimburse the  
17 Department of Public Health, HIV Research Section, in the amount of \$896,321 under the terms  
18 of this agreement; and

19 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds, The University of California, San  
20 Francisco, requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on  
21 file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 001712 ; and,

22 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$96,423; now,  
23 therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Health is hereby authorized to enter  
25 into a subcontract in the amount of \$896,321 with The University of California, San Francisco,  
the primary contractor, during the period covered by this Agreement; retroactive to July 1, 2000;  
and, be it


1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
2 Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of Health  
4 to enter into similar agreements with The University of California, San Francisco, if the  
10/12/00 agreement recurs or is renewed; and, be it


