3 AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH, HIV RESEARCH SECTION,
4 TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$174,261 WITH THE FRED
5 HUTCHINSON CANCER RESEARCH CENTER, THE PRIMARY CONTRACTOR, TO
6 PROVIDE CLINICAL TRIAL LEADERSHIP AND LIAISON EXPERTISE TO THE HIV
7 VACCINE TRIALS NETWORK LEADERSHIP GROUP; RETROACTIVE TO SEPTEMBER
8 30, 1999.

9 WHEREAS, The Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center has received funds from the
10 National Institutes of Health for a project entitled HIV Vaccine Trial Network Leadership Group:
11 Scientific Leadership-Part A; and,

12 WHEREAS, The Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center as the primary contractor has
13 requested that the Department of Public Health, HIV Research Section, enter into a subcontract
14 to participate in this project by providing clinical trial leadership and liaison expertise to this
15 project; and,

16 WHEREAS, The Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center has agreed to reimburse the
17 Department of Public Health, HIV Research Section in the amount of \$174,261 under the terms
18 of this subcontract; and

19 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds, The Fred Hutchinson Cancer
20 Research Center requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which
21 is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 001713 ; and,

22 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$24,036; now,
23 therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Health is hereby authorized to enter
25 into a subcontract in the amount of \$174,261 with The Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research
Center, the primary contractor, during the period covered by this Agreement; retroactive to
September 30, 1999; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, The Controller should be urged to designate the position created under the agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position, which would terminate when the agreement expires.


