WHEREAS, Maitri was founded in 1987 by Zen Priest Issan Dorsey as an AIDS hospice for low-income people; and,

WHEREAS, Bill Musick joined Maitri in 1997 prior to its move from its original 8-bed home to a new, state-licensed 15-bed residence for people severely disabled with AIDS; and,

WHEREAS, During his tenure, Maitri opened its new and expanded facility, obtained its state license, and expanded its scope of service to include care for both hospice patients and those who need 24-hour nursing and attendant care; and,

WHEREAS, Under his management, Maitri's budget grew from approximately \$500,000 to over \$2 million; and,

WHEREAS, During his tenure, Maitri's program staff maintained a near-perfect monitoring record in annual evaluations by the San Francisco Department of Public Health; and,

WHEREAS, Bill Musick should be commended for his exemplary leadership as executive director of Maitri; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco commends Bill Musick for his years of service as the Executive Director of Maitri.




