

[Acceptance of Gift of Photo-Enforcement Cameras]

2 AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GIFT OF ELEVEN PHOTO-
3 ENFORCEMENT CAMERAS FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DEPARTMENT
4 OF TRANSPORTATION.

5 WHEREAS, The mission of the Department of Parking and Traffic includes
6 the improvement of traffic safety as its most important task; and,

7 WHEREAS, Red light violators cause approximately twenty-five percent of all
8 traffic collisions at signalized intersections in San Francisco; and,

9 WHEREAS, San Francisco's pilot Red Light Photo Enforcement Program
10 reduced the number of motorists violating red lights at camera locations by more
11 than 40 percent; and,

12 WHEREAS, California law greatly increased the revenue received from each
13 red light violation citation to provide adequate funding to cover all operational costs
14 of the Red Light Photo Enforcement Program; and,

15 WHEREAS, The Parking and Traffic Commission has authorized the
16 expansion of the Red Light Photo Enforcement Program, which is currently
17 underway;

18 WHEREAS, The State of California, Department of Transportation has offered
19 eleven photo-enforcement cameras for the following intersection:

20 Park Presidio Boulevard and Lake Street

21 Park Presidio and Geary Boulevards

22 Park Presidio Boulevard and Fulton Street

23 Marina Boulevard and Lyon Street

Route 101 / Richardson Avenue and Francisco Street

to be included as part of San Francisco's Red Light Photo Enforcement Program; now,
therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors, on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco accepts the State of California Department of Transportation's gift of eleven photo-enforcement cameras.


