8 WHEREAS, Due to the highly competitive real estate market, arts and non-profit
9 organizations are being forced out of their performance, rehearsal, and office space, and are
10 either leaving San Francisco or closing down; and,

11 WHEREAS, A vibrant arts community is invaluable for maintaining a healthy tourist
12 industry, which is also a major source of the Airport's revenue; and,

13 WHEREAS, The purchase of buildings for use by arts and non-profit organizations
14 ensures that these organizations will be protected from future competitive real estate markets;
15 now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
17 urges the Arts Commission and the Mayor's Office of Community Development to investigate
18 reserving a portion of funds received from the San Francisco Airport to be used for the
19 purchase of performance and office space for arts and other non-profit organizations
