7 REIMBURSE TUITION EXPENSES OF LIBRARY EMPLOYEES PURSUING A DEGREE
8 OR CERTIFICATE IN LIBRARY SCIENCE AT AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER
9 EDUCATION. EMPLOYEES PARTICIPATING IN THE PROGRAM APPLIED TO, AND
10 WERE SELECTED BY, THE CALIFORNIA STATE LIBRARY.
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13 WHEREAS, The California State Library's Public Library Staff Education Program is
14 dedicated to providing tuition reimbursement for library staff pursuing a degree or certification in
15 Library Science, and

16 WHEREAS, five non-professional employees of San Francisco Public Library applied to
17 the California State Library to participate and receive specific tuition reimbursement amounts
18 and were accepted into the program, and

20 WHEREAS, The California State Library has awarded \$12,014 to San Francisco Public
21 Library to reimburse the student/employees for Fall 2000, Spring 2001, and Summer 2001
22 Tuition fees, and an additional sum of \$1,201 to cover indirect costs, and

24 WHEREAS, Student/employees will provide official transcripts and registration fee
25 receipts as evidence of completing said classes prior to receiving reimbursement, and


WHEREAS, The San Francisco Public Library has a goal of promoting equal access to professional development opportunities for all employees, now therefore be it


