

1 [Zoning - Extension of Planning Commission Review Period]  
2 EXTENDING THE PRESCRIBED TIME WITHIN WHICH THE PLANNING COMMISSION  
3 MAY RENDER ITS DECISION ON PROPOSED ORDINANCES TO AMEND THE PLANNING  
4 CODE TO CREATE THE GLEN PARK SPECIAL USE SUBDISTRICT.

5 WHEREAS, On June 26, 2000, the Board of Supervisors initiated the process to  
6 amend the Municipal Code, Part II, Chapter II (Planning Code), when the Honorable Mark  
7 Leno introduced two proposed ordinances to create a Glen Park Special Use Subdistrict with  
8 commercial use size limitations, and to amend the Zoning Map to reflect the new Glen Park  
9 Special Use Subdistrict, copies of which are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors  
10 in File No. 001208 and File No. 001209, respectively; and,

11 WHEREAS, On July 5, 2000, the proposed ordinances were referred to the Planning  
12 Commission, which currently is reviewing the proposed ordinances; and,

13 WHEREAS, The Board, in accordance with Planning Code Section 306.4(d) may, by  
14 resolution, extend the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission is to render its  
15 decision on proposed amendments to the Planning Code initiated by the Board of  
16 Supervisors; and,

17 WHEREAS, on October 10, 2000, in Resolution 891-00, the Board of Supervisors  
18 extended the period within which the Planning Commission was to render its decision on the  
19 proposed amendments for an additional 90 days, or until January 1, 2001; and

20 WHEREAS, The Planning Department has requested additional time to review the  
21 proposed ordinances; and,

22 WHEREAS, The Board deems it appropriate in this instance to grant to the Planning  
23 Commission an additional 90 days to review the proposed ordinances and render its decision;  
24 now, therefore, be it




