

1 [Federal grant to the Department of Public Health for a mobile methadone program.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Department of Public Health, Population Health and**  
4 **Prevention, Community Substance Abuse Services, to accept retroactively and**  
5 **expend first year grant funds of \$235,000 from the Substance Abuse and**  
6 **Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) and the Center for Substance**  
7 **Abuse Treatment (CSAT) for the mobile methadone maintenance program and**  
8 **to enter into an agreement which includes a rights in data clause for the use of**  
9 **these funds; providing for ratification of action previously taken.**

11 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health has applied for and been  
12 awarded a two year grant from SAMHSA/CSAT in the amount of \$235,000 for the  
13 first year of a mobile methadone program; and,

14 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, SAMHSA/CSAT  
15 requires the SFDPH to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is  
16 on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 002214, which is  
17 hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

19 WHEREAS, The Agreement contains a certain provision described below,  
20 which requires the approval of the Board of Supervisors; and,

22 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$5,576;  
23 now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Health is hereby authorized to  
2 accept retroactively and expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco  
3 Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it


4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into  
5 the Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the  
7 provision in the Agreement pursuant to which the City agrees to grant a royalty-free,  
8 nonexclusive, and irrevocable license for the use of data developed under the  
9 contract; and, be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the  
11 Director of Health to enter into similar agreements with SAMHSA/CSAT if the grant  
12 recurs or is renewed; and, be it


13 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller should be urged to designate the  
14 positions created under the grant as "G" or grant-funded positions, which would  
15 terminate when the grant expires.




