7 WHEREAS, The Grocery Outlet, located on the corner of Harrison and  
8 Division Streets has been providing low cost food to ten of thousands to Bay  
9 Area residents for the past 25 years; and

10 WHEREAS, The grocery outlet provides quality groceries at low prices to  
11 the City's working class families, low-income residents, the poor, seniors on fixed  
12 incomes and homeless people, and

13 WHEREAS; The building was recently purchased by Best Buy Electronics,  
14 which plans to immediately demolish the building to build an electronics retail  
15 store; and

16 WHEREAS, It is in the interest of the City's working class families and low-  
17 income residents to facilitate maintaining the continued operation of the Grocery  
18 Outlet; and

19 WHEREAS, It is also the policy of the City and County of San Francisco to  
20 preserve the diversity of the City, prevent the displacement by chain stores of  
21 small and locally owned business; be it therefore

22 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San  
23 Francisco urges Best Buy to investigate ways to maintain the continued  
24 operation of the Grocery Outlet; be it

25 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the owners  
of Grocery Outlet to consider the option of remaining at the current site and  
renegotiate with Best Buy to work out an amenable solution.
