3 **Resolution establishing the Clean Streets Initiative.**

5 WHEREAS, The City currently has an adopt-a-street program which allows residents,  
6 neighborhood associations, and merchant associations to adopt streets to keep clean; and

7 WHEREAS, The program creates a cleaner more pleasant environment for everyone  
8 who lives, works, and shops in adopted areas; and,

9 WHEREAS, The amount of litter on San Francisco's streets has doubled in the last ten  
10 years, from 10,000 to 20,000 tons per year; and,

11 WHEREAS, Keeping the streets clean takes the effort and cooperation of city  
12 departments as well as residents and businesses; and,

13 WHEREAS, The State has had tremendous success with the Adopt-A-Highway  
14 Program, which allows businesses and nonprofit organizations as well as individuals to adopt  
15 portions of highways and maintain their cleanliness; and,

16 WHEREAS, The City would benefit from a program in which businesses and nonprofits  
17 could participate along with merchant groups, neighborhood groups, and individuals in  
18 keeping the streets clean, removing graffiti, and planting trees; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
20 does hereby create the Clean Streets Initiative Pilot Program on the Great Highway; and, be it

21 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Department of  
22 Public Works to oversee the program and work with San Francisco Beautiful and the  
23 Recreation and Parks Department in implementing the program.
