

1 [Accept-Expend City Grant]

2 AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND A
3 GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$72,450 FROM THE CALIFORNIA INTEGRATED WASTE
4 MANAGEMENT BOARD

5 WHEREAS, Public Resources Code Section 42000 authorizes the California Integrated Waste
6 Management Board to conduct market development activities to strengthen demand by manufacturers
7 and end-use consumers for recyclable materials collected by municipalities, nonprofit organizations,
8 and private entities; and,

9 WHEREAS, the concept of *Sustainable Buildings*, also referred to as *Green Buildings*, is an
10 integrated approach which encompasses integrated waste management objectives such as building
11 material efficiency, construction and demolition waste reduction, and maximization of reused- and
12 recycled-content building and landscaping materials; and,

13 WHEREAS, on May 24, 1999, the Board of Supervisors passed the Resource Efficient City
14 Building Ordinance 148-99, which directed the Department of the Environment to coordinate a pilot
15 program of green design practices for new construction in City facilities and to include training for City
16 design staff; and,

17 WHEREAS, on September 25th, 2000, the San Francisco Board of Supervisors approved a
18 resolution authorizing the Director of the Department of Environment to apply for \$72,450 from the
19 California Integrated Waste Management Board for the development of a Green Building tool kit and
20 training workshops; and,

21 WHEREAS, on October 18th, 2000 the California Integrated Waste Management Board
22 approved the awarding of \$72,450 to San Francisco for the development of a Green Building toolkit
23 and training workshops; and,

24 WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now,
25 therefore, be it






FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget.


