WHEREAS, In San Francisco, 65% of non-direct service nonprofits are leaving or considering leaving the city in the next few years because of the space crisis; and,

WHEREAS, Earth Island Institute, Rainforest Action Network, and International Rivers Network have joined together to invest in an organizational infrastructure to make office space for environmental groups permanently available through non-profit ownership of the building, known as the David Brower Center, honoring the work and accomplishments of its namesake; and,

WHEREAS, The Brower Center is currently envisioned as a 50,000 to 70,000 square foot building, located in the San Francisco Bay Area near public transportation; and,

WHEREAS, Sponsoring organizations intend to perform an extensive search for land and buildings that are below market value, including piers and port buildings, surplus schools, government property, redevelopment agencies, military base closure, and donated real estate; and,

WHEREAS, The project plan includes formation of a separate 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation for the sole purpose of being the developer, owner, and manager of the building; and,
