9 WHEREAS, Global warming is a matter of utmost concern for public health, the environment, and the
10 economy of California; and

13 WHEREAS, The United Nations' Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change has determined that by
14 2100, global warming will increase global mean surface temperatures from three to eleven degrees
15 Fahrenheit, raise sea levels by up to three feet, cause the retreat of glaciers worldwide, and accelerate
16 incidents of El Nino and resulting droughts and floods; and

19 WHEREAS, Global warming is projected to increase smog in non-attainment areas, causing increased
20 hospitalizations and health care costs to the State; and

23 WHEREAS, Global warming is projected to have severe economic impacts to California's the
24 agriculture, fishing, aviation, tourism, construction, insurance, trucking, and skiing industries, as well to


