[Zoning - Extension of Temporary Live/Work Moratorium]

Resolution extending for an additional six-month period interim controls to prohibit the construction of new live/work developments.

WHEREAS, In February, 2001, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 111-01, imposing for six months a temporary moratorium on the approval of any demolition permit, grading permit, site permit, building permit, conditional use authorization, or any other land use entitlement for live/work development on property located in the City and County of San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, The temporary live/work moratorium went into effect on February 23, 2001, when the Mayor returned Resolution 111-01 without his signature; and,

WHEREAS, The temporary live/work moratorium will expire on August 23, 2001; and WHEREAS, The 13-member Live/Work Task Force, established by the Board of Supervisors to recommend legislative policy on live/work development and related matters for consideration by the Board, is finalizing its report and will be submitting it by mid-July, 2001; and

WHEREAS, At its public meeting held on July 2, 2001, the Live/Work Task Force adopted a recommendation that the Board extend the temporary live/work moratorium for an additional six months or until such time as the Board adopts permanent legislation, whichever is sooner; and

WHEREAS, An extension of the temporary live/work moratorium is needed to bridge the gap between the initial moratorium and the development and enactment of permanent controls; and,

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors is authorized by Planning Code Section 306.7 to extend the duration of the temporary live/work moratorium for an additional six months pending the enactment of permanent zoning controls; and,

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors has balanced the hardship on property owners from extending the interim moratorium against the detriment to the public if no extension were adopted; now, there, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby extends the six-month moratorium on new live/work development set forth in Board Resolution 111-01 for an additional six months pending the development and enactment of permanent legislation; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the extension of the temporary moratorium will become effective upon the enactment of this Resolution and the temporary moratorium on new live/work development shall remain in effect until February 23, 2002 or until the adoption of permanent legislation, whichever shall first occur.
