15 neighbors, and daily associates feel the void left behind by a once-vibrant spirit; now,  
16 therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors, on behalf of the all citizens of the City and  
18 County of San Francisco, express our deepest sympathy and steadfast camaraderie with the  
19 people of New York City, those who lost their lives in the collapse of the World Trade Center  
20 buildings, and all those whose lives have been forever altered by the tragic events of  
21 September 11, 2001; and, be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco stands ready to  
23 support our distant neighbors in New York with both spiritual and material assistance as
