WHEREAS, on September 22, 2001, a two alarm house fire broke out at 87 Maddux Ave, in the Silver Terrace area, and,

WHEREAS, The residence at 87 Maddux were unable to flee because an electrically controlled metal security gate at the front door could not open after the fire knocked out power to the house; and,

WHEREAS, Without thinking about his own safety, Fourteen year old Marquez Helton, who lived across the street, knocked open the locked gate with an ax to allow one of the two adults to who were in the home to flee; and,

WHEREAS, As a result of Marquez Helton's selfless and heroic act, one of the six family members were able to escape the fire with minor injuries, and; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco extends its highest commendation in recognition of Fourteen year old Marquez Helton for his selfless and heroic act on September 22, 2001.
