[Deploring Hate Crimes in San Francisco]

Resolution deploring all types of Hate Crimes in San Francisco, specifically those that are perpetrated against Arab Americans during this time of national crisis.

WHEREAS, A Hate Crime is committed when someone uses violence against you or your property, or threatens violence because of who you are, or who people believe you are. It is a violent crime that is directed against an individual, group, or organization, because of their race, religion, sexual orientation, national origin, ethnicity, or gender; and

WHEREAS, According to the Community United Against Violence, in order for something to be a Hate Crime, there must be a crime-- such as assault, homicide, robbery, and something that demonstrates hatred or bias, for example: it can Involve the use of language or symbols, racial epithets, anti-gay slurs, or involve use of objects or items which indicate bias, such as a burning cross on the victim's lawn; and

WHEREAS, Among other things, it can occur while the victim was engaged in activities promoting the rights of the targeted group, or It can coincides with a religious or cultural holiday, such as Yom Kippur or Gay Pride; and

WHEREAS, Sadly some of those acts have occurred in San Francisco; with three last week in the Mission; City Blend, Mission Economic Cultural Association, and the Gallaria De La Raza; and

WHEREAS, Now more than ever, individuals who commit hate crimes and try to turn us against one another must be stopped; and therefore, be it

RESOLVED That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby deplore Hate Crimes of all kinds in San Francisco.
