

1 [Commendation of Lake Merced stakeholders.]

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3 **Resolution commending the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission, the City of**
4 **Daly City, the Olympic Club, the Lake Merced Golf and County Club, and the San**
5 **Francisco Golf Club for their work in reaching landmark agreements that will set in**
6 **motion a plan to restore Lake Merced.**

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8 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco, the City of Daly City, the Olympic
9 Club, the Lake Merced Golf and Country Club, and the San Francisco Golf Club, are Lake
10 Merced's primary stakeholders ; and,

11 WHEREAS, The Lake Merced Task Force, Friends of Lake Merced, Cal Trout, and
12 other interested residents of San Francisco and Daly City have been urging these
13 stakeholders to work together to find a mutually agreeable solution to the problems in and
14 around Lake Merced; and,

15 WHEREAS, The stakeholders have participated in approximately six months of judicial
16 mediation, and were recently joined by representatives of Cal Trout; and,

17 WHEREAS, Prior to these six months of judicial mediation, the Lake Merced Task
18 Force did an extremely commendable job of acting as the first organization to bring all of Lake
19 Merced's users into a partnership; and,

20 WHEREAS, The judicial mediation resulted in agreement by all the parties to two
21 landmark term sheets that set the framework for the future management of the Westside
22 Basin Aquifer, the Aquifer underlying Lake Merced; and,

23 WHEREAS, The first term sheet consists of proposed conjunctive use principles
24 between San Francisco and Daly City; and,

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1 WHEREAS, The second term sheet consists of principles of an agreement on the
2 proposed addition of stormwater to Lake Merced from the Daly City area, as well as a
3 mutually agreed upon December 17, 2001 deadline for the conclusion of a recycled water
4 purchase agreement between Daly City, the three Lake Merced area golf clubs, and the San
5 Francisco Public Utilities Commision; now, therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
7 commends the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission, the City of Daly City, the Olympic
8 Club, the Lake Merced Golf and County Club, and the San Francisco Golf Club for their work
9 in reaching landmark agreements that will set in motion a plan to restore Lake Merced.
