

1 [Congresswoman Nancy Pelosi]

2 Resolution commending Congresswoman Nancy Pelosi on her
3 tremendous contributions to improve the health of San Francisco.

4 WHEREAS, Congresswoman Nancy Pelosi represents the 8th
5 District of California, which includes San Francisco; and

6 WHEREAS, On October 10, 2001, Congresswoman Nancy Pelosi
7 was elected to the post of House Democratic Whip; and

8 WHEREAS, When Congresswoman Pelosi assumes this position on
9 January 15, 2002, she will be the first woman ever to hold a
10 leadership position in the 212 year history of Congress; and

11 WHEREAS, Congresswoman Pelosi has been a passionate
12 advocate for health issues affecting San Franciscans; and

13 WHEREAS, In her position on the Labor, Health and Human
14 Services and Education Subcommittee of the House Appropriations
15 Committee, Congresswoman Pelosi has fought hard for increased
16 federal funding for health programs, including HIV/AIDS
17 programs, substance abuse treatment, and women's health
18 programs; and

19 WHEREAS, Congresswoman Pelosi has been actively involved in
20 Congressional initiatives that support our nation's safety net
21 system of health care, create and sustain a public health
22 infrastructure of disease control and surveillance, establish
23 workplace safety protections, and ensure the continued
24 availability of HIV/AIDS programs and services; and

1 WHEREAS, in 2000, Congresswoman Pelosi was a leader in the
2 reauthorization of the Ryan White CARE Act, working tirelessly
3 to minimize reductions to funding for the San Francisco eligible
4 metropolitan area and to ensure that critical HIV/AIDS programs
5 provided in the City and County were not destabilized as a
6 result of these reductions; and

7 WHEREAS, Congresswoman Pelosi secured \$1.105 million in the
8 2000-01 federal budget for HIV/AIDS services provided to women
9 and persons of color at San Francisco General Hospital to
10 mitigate funding reductions resulting from changes to the
11 allocation formula made in the reauthorization of the Ryan White
12 CARE Act; and

13 WHEREAS, Congresswoman Pelosi has secured more than \$3.1
14 million in direct federal funding from the Substance Abuse and
15 Mental Health Services Administration for San Francisco's
16 Treatment on Demand initiative, including 1.105 million in the
17 2000-2001 Federal Budget; and,

18 WHEREAS, Congresswoman Pelosi has been instrumental in
19 securing funds for a spectrum of critical services and concerns
20 including support for housing, homeless assistance, social
21 services, transportation and economic revitalization; and,

22 WHEREAS, Congresswoman Pelosi has been a powerful voice for
23 San Francisco's safety net system of health care, supporting
24 initiatives that would increase funding for the hospitals and
25

1 health systems that provide care to our city's most vulnerable
2 low-income and uninsured populations; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors
4 acknowledges and appreciates the tireless dedication and deepest
5 commitment of Congresswoman Pelosi to ensuring the health of San
6 Francisco; and, be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Board of
8 Supervisors shall send a copy of this resolution to the office
9 of Congresswoman Nancy Pelosi.


