8 Representatives representing San Francisco in a special election in 1987; and

9 WHEREAS, Congresswoman Pelosi moved to San Francisco at the age of 29 with her
10 husband, Paul, and quickly became immersed in Democratic Party politics; and,

11 WHEREAS, Congresswoman Pelosi's top priority has been federal support for
12 programs serving people living with HIV and AIDS, demonstrated by being first in the nation to
13 have a full-time staffer on AIDS issues; and,

14 WHEREAS, Congresswoman Pelosi landed a coveted spot on the House
15 Appropriations Committee where all spending bills originate; and,

16 WHEREAS, Congresswoman Pelosi's annual fight to revoke China's trade status
17 because of its human rights abuses has not wavered in the face of intense pressure from
18 monied special interests and the Chinese government; and,

19 WHEREAS, Congresswoman Pelosi was overwhelmingly elected Democratic Whip in
20 the United States House of Representatives by a vote of 118-95 on October 10, 2001; and,

21 WHEREAS, All San Francisco stands to benefit from Congresswoman Pelosi's work in
22 this new position of prominence; now, therefore, be it

23 **RESOLVED**, That the Board of Supervisors commends Congresswoman Nancy Pelosi
24 on the occasion of being elected Whip, extends its congratulations to the Congresswoman
25 and her able staff, and thanks her supporters in the House for their faith in her work.
