3 **Resolution urging the Small Business Commission to coordinate with small**
4 **businesses throughout the City to create a Violent Crime Information Reward Fund.**

6 WHEREAS, Violent crime in San Francisco is unacceptable to our City's residents,
7 visitors to our City, and our City's business community; and,

8 WHEREAS, During the weekend of November 16-18, one man was shot and killed on
9 Mariposa Street, one man was found shot dead in a Steiner street residence in the Western
10 Addition, two men were shot in drive by shootings on Mission Street and on Bryant Street,
11 three men were stabbed, and a couple was robbed at gunpoint at a South of Market gas
12 station; and,

13 WHEREAS, Information related to these crimes, as well as to other violent crimes, is
14 essential to the successful prosecution of the perpetrators of the crimes; and,

15 WHEREAS, An offer of a reward for useful information generally assists police in their
16 investigations of violent crimes; and,

17 WHEREAS, Violent crime threatens the business community, in particular, as it
18 discourages consumers from venturing out and purchasing goods from the businesses; and

19 WHEREAS, The Small Business Commission serves as a conduit between the City's
20 numerous small businesses and the City's government; and,

21 WHEREAS, The Small Business Commission could organize a campaign among small
22 businesses, who are affected by violent crime, to create a Violent Crime Information Reward
23 Fund by encouraging them to contribute to the Fund; and,
