3 **Resolution appointing Christine Smith, term ending June 1, 2002, to the Transgender**  
4 **Civil Rights Implementation Task Force, residency requirement waived.**  
5

6 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
7 does hereby appoint hereinafter designated person to serve as a member of the Transgender  
8 Civil Rights Implementation Task Force, pursuant to the provisions of Resolution No. 102-00,  
9 for the term specified:

10 Christine Smith (residency requirement waived), succeeding Shawna Virago, resigned,  
11 Seat No. 10, must be a member of the transgender community, for the unexpired portion of a  
12 two-year term ending June 1, 2002; and, be it

13 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 14 1. The membership of the Transgender Civil Rights Implementation Task Force has a  
15 goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- 16 2. Applicant Christine Smith, a new appointee, who is not a resident of San Francisco,  
17 is a person with experience that uniquely qualifies him/her to serve on the  
18 Transgender Civil Rights Implementation Task Force.
- 19 3. The Transgender Civil Rights Implementation Task Force has attempted to fill the  
20 position, for which Christine Smith was nominated, with an individual who is a City  
21 resident and who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has  
22 been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Christine  
23 Smith is qualified to serve on the Transgender Civil Rights Implementation Task  
24 Force.

1 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no  
2 other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco and who has the  
3 specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is  
4 willing to serve on the Transgender Civil Rights Implementation Task Force at this  
5 time; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency  
7 requirement for Christine Smith, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing  
8 to serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s)  
9 appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the  
10 Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
