3 **Resolution commending the Filipino Bar Association of Northern California, the San**
4 **Mateo Legal Aid Society and the City of Daly City for sponsoring a citizenship**
5 **workshop to enable airport security screeners to maintain employment in their current**
6 **positions once the Federal Aviation Security Bill is implemented.**

8 WHEREAS, The new Aviation Security Bill requires that all airport security screeners
9 be U.S. citizens; and

10 WHEREAS, Approximately eighty percent of all airport security screeners at San
11 Francisco International Airport are foreign nationals; and,

12 WHEREAS, Eighty percent of the airport security screeners will not be able to keep
13 their jobs when the Aviation Security Bill is implemented; and,

14 WHEREAS, The Department of Transportation will not likely implement the
15 federalization of airport security screeners until the end of 2002; and,

16 WHEREAS, The Filipino Bar Association of Northern California, the San Mateo Legal
17 Aid Society and the City of Daly City will be sponsoring a citizenship workshop to facilitate the
18 application process for any airport security screener wishing to become an American citizen in
19 order to maintain employment in their current positions; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
21 commend the Filipino Bar Association of Northern California, the San Mateo Legal Aid Society
22 and the City of Daly City for sponsoring a citizenship workshop in order to allow airport
23 security screeners to maintain working in their current positions once the new Federal Aviation
24 Security bill is implemented; and, be it




