11 WHEREAS, SFDPH has applied for and been awarded a grant from CDC in the
12 amount of \$315,828 for the first year of three years for HIV prevention intervention research
13 on the efficacy of condom skills building; and,

14 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CDC requires the City to enter
15 into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a notice of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
16 Supervisors in File No. 012260, which is hereby declared to be a part of this
17 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

18 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$4,972; now,
19 therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively a
21 grant in the amount of \$315,828 from CDC; and, be it


22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the
23 grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement pursuant to the
24 San Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it

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FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the Agreement in behalf of the City; and, be it


FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position created under the grant as a "G" or grant-funded position, which would terminate when the grant expires.






