12 from CDC in the amount of \$65,000 to reduce HIV and HCV risk behaviors; and,

13 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds, SAMHSA requires the City to enter
14 into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a notice of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
15 Supervisors in File No. 012261, which is hereby declared to be a part of this
16 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

17 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$8,965; now,
18 therefore, be it


19 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a one-time grant
20 supplemental in the amount of \$65,000 from CDC; and, be it

21 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the
22 grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement pursuant to the
23 San Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
25 Agreement in behalf of the City; and, be it


1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position


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


