**Resolution appointing Rann Parker and Barbara Garcia, terms to be determined, to the  
4 Emergency Room Diversion Task Force, residency requirement waived.**

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
7 does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the  
8 Emergency Room Diversion Task Force, pursuant to the provisions of Resolution No. 536-01,  
9 for the term specified:

Rann Parker (residency requirement waived), seat 13, must be a representative of the  
11 Community Substance Abuse Services, term to be determined;

Barbara Garcia, seat 16, must be the director of the Population, Health and Prevention  
13 Unit in the Department of Public Health, term to be determined; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

15

1. The membership of the Emergency Room Diversion Task Force has a goal to be  
16 representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.

17

2. Applicant Rann Parker, new appointee, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a  
18 person with experience that uniquely qualifies him/her to serve on the Emergency  
19 Room Diversion Task Force.

3. The Emergency Room Diversion Task Force has attempted to fill the position, for  
21 which Rann Parker was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and  
22 who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to  
23 do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Rann Parker is qualified  
24 to serve on the Emergency Room Diversion Task Force.

1           4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there are no  
2           other possible representative, who are a resident of San Francisco and who have  
3           the specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by these applicants, and  
4           who are willing to serve on the Emergency Room Diversion Task Force at this time;  
5           and, be it

6           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency  
7           requirement for Rann Parker, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to  
8           serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s)  
9           appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the  
10          Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.


