3 **Resolution urging the state Legislature to amend the State Education Code to create a**
4 **default placement process for a random selection of public school students into one-**
5 **third of student admission slots in charter schools.**

7 WHEREAS, There are currently six charter schools located in the San Francisco
8 Unified School District: Gateway Charter High School , Leadership Charter High School,
9 Urban Pioneer Experiential Charter High School, Jump Charter High School, and Life
10 Learning Academy Charter High School, and Creative Arts Charter Elementary; and,

11 WHEREAS, Enrollment for admission to charter schools is open to all public school
12 students, however, the student must apply through a process separate from the standard
13 school enrollment process; and,

14 WHEREAS, The additional burden of applying to a charter school has resulted in lower
15 enrollment by economically disadvantaged students and those deemed to be under-
16 performing; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the California State
18 Legislature to amend the State Education Code to create a default placement process for a
19 random selection of public school students into one-third of student admission slots in charter
20 schools; and, be it

21 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors request the clerk of the Board
22 of Supervisors to forward copies of this resolution to San Francisco's delegation in the state
23 Legislature and to the Governor.




